“ I adopted a tiny 6 week old orange tabby kitten in 1997. He was named Buddy and he and I bonded quickly - he slept with me every night. He was never a big cat but he had a very big personality. He didn't tolerate other cats getting into his personal space but was pleasant otherwise. He accumulated a large human fan club in his 24 years of life.

Buddy developed signs of renal failure 2 years ago but his vet, Dr. Weber, recommended giving him daily fluids and said "hell that cat might out live you." I began to believe him as Buddy survived 2 seizures and 2 other emergencies in those two years. He rallied each time.

But two weeks ago he showed signs that his 24 year old body had been used up. Sunday, January 31, 2021, Dr. Weber gently eased him over the bridge with me and Buddy's human, Tyler, at his side. Even 24 years was not enough time with that crazy feline but I am so grateful he was mine.
