

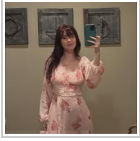


## Maxwell Leon Albano

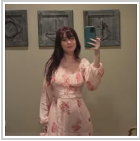

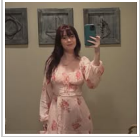
