On March 17th, as we were preparing for bed, Mo started suddenly gasping for breath. We rushed him to the Emergency Vets and within the hour he was put to sleep. What a horrid shock!! We are devastated at the loss and the poodle family members left behind are suffering from obvious grief.

Mo was my heart. He was funny, smart, tiny, and pulled the covers off me every morning. In exchange for getting me out of bed, I had to carry him outside. He was carried while the others had to walk out. He's a super intelligent boy and he and Jack could get into some very 'fun' trouble. I could never get angry at them because their hijinx were well planned and highly intelligently orchestrated. Mo was my little lover. He is/was a gentle boy and delicate, where Jack is clumsy and silly. I took so many pictures of the poodles that they all knew their standing order and it was Mo who helped them obtain order. He kept the little girls from going out in the street and watched over them like he was the older sibling.

My heart is not empty as I still have the other 5 family members. They too are my heart and center of my World. Mo did leave a huge vacuum in our daily lives and we miss him so very much! I still cry and miss the empty spot on my pillow where he slept. The other tiny babies will not sleep in his spot nor will they touch his favorite toys. The poodles range in size from 2.5 lbs to 9 lbs. Mo was on the smaller end. He loved to wear sweaters and pajamas. He loved it when I sang to him and inserted his name in his favorite songs. He loved the story of the night they were born (we almost lost the twins and Chloe).

I have been fighting an extended illness and take infusions and many meds. Some days are very hard for me but Mo and the others

*care for me and bring healing. They will continue to do so until the last one goes.*

*Our poodles are cared for very well! We daily make gourmet food and snacks. They had oatmeal, eggs, etc for breakfast and they ate chicken breast, beef, turkey or lamb for their meats and fresh or frozen veggies and fruits. They love rice and ABC pasta. They love coffee and cookies too occasionally, but do NOT tell their vet! Shhhh!*

*Thank you for allowing me to tell a little about the darling I love so much! I am unsure how long grieving will last ... but it has yet to improve even a little. I have painted several pictures of him, designed a couple pieces of jewelry (I am a jeweler), and I view and watch his pictures and videos daily. This brings comfort. I will gladly share some of their pics and videos. In one video, Mo's father, Biscotti, had a shot at the vet's. Mo knew his 17 y o father dreaded shots. In the video Mo gives his Dad a hug after the shot. So cute! I may also post the picture I painted of him. The other photos will just be Mo being his loving, darling self.*

*His cremains came in today, so my darling Mo is back home. We had his mom, Chloe, cremated also and each will follow suit when it is their turn. I want them with me forever.*

*All good things come from Heaven! Since the Bible says that there are animals in the Heavenly Realm, then I firmly believe the pets of the righteous will be there too.*

*I wish I had answers as to what happened to my little Mo. Perhaps they will soon come. I wish I wld have thought ahead to preserve their lineage but I did not. Mo and Jack and their sister, CoCo Chanel are dark chocolate brown. The father is marked like a German Shepherd (tri-colored/wolf sable), Chloe (Mom) and Sophia Loren (sister-1st littler) are white and Goldie Hawn (sister-1st litter) is strawberry blonde. I truly regret not preserving their lineage. I am also unable to locate the breeders who were from Jasper, AL area and Athens, AL to notify them of his passing. Is this a genetic problem?*
