Georgia “Mama Kitty” Busic, using all 9 of her lives, passed away at home on April 24, 2017, after a brief battle with mammary cancer. She lived 13 ½ leisurely years in a home with various dogs and humans. She was born in Hueytown, Alabama and was adopted by Mark and Misty Busic. Misty picked her out of a litter of kittens and brought her home to her sister, a border collie, named Shakes. Later, they were joined by Prada (Sharpei/Basset mix), Lady (Chihuahua), Toot (Boston Terrier) and Bodhi (Border collie/terrier mix). She also had two human brothers, Gage and Harper. She enjoyed napping after eating big meals, terrorizing Lady and Toot, watching bird and fish videos on YouTube, laying in the window planning her bird attacks, telling inappropriate jokes and intimidation. In her younger days, she was a bit wild and enjoyed the night life. She would come home many nights after getting into fights in the alley behind our house. She wore her significant fighter cauliflower ears as a badge of honor. Another token from her wild nights was a litter of kittens for herself. All went to wonderful homes. Axel and Munson were the two kittens that stayed with their mom. Sadly, Munson died shortly after birth in a freak accident with one of the human brothers and Axel died at age 4 of feline leukemia. This really didn't break Mama Kitty because she was already such a tough cat. She was graceful when she needed to be, she still had that fighting alley cat in her that was never afraid to come out. She not only enjoyed fighting other cats, but she loved fighting dogs too. If she was in one room and heard a scuffle break out between dogs in another room, she would immediately bolt into that room to get in the middle of the fight. And more times than not, she would be the one instigating the fights. Mama Kitty was always an introvert, even after moving to Helena three years ago. Many people tried to get close to her, but she kept it safe and would only allow occasional petting. (with some slaps thrown in if you overstayed your welcome) One person she always stayed close to was her mom, Misty. She laid in her lap or near her

at every moment. If she was mad at her mom, she would sleep next to her dad, but that was rare. Her family is going to miss her terribly. She is predeceased in death by her sisters, Prada and Lady, and by her babies, Axel and Munson. Her sister and oldest friend, Shakes, will grieve and miss her the most.
