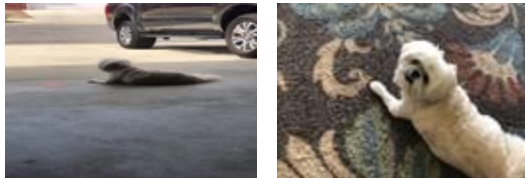

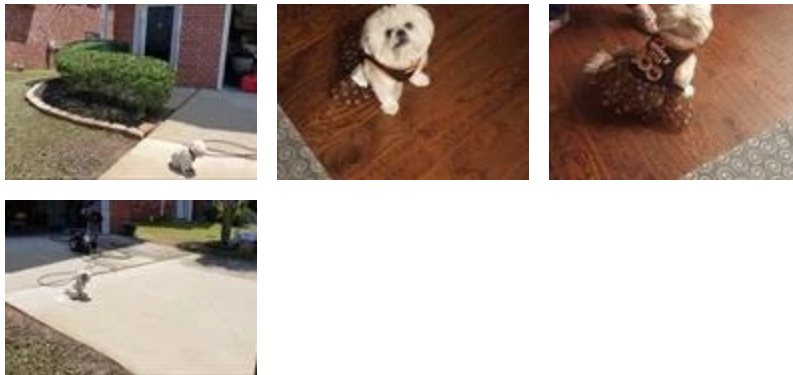
“ Dear Roxie the years went by to fast I will miss you dearly and sitting in the garage will never be the same without you ! Love you forever Dad

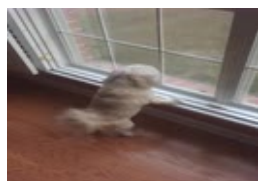
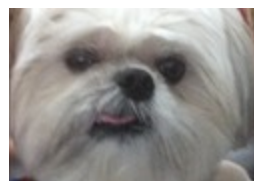

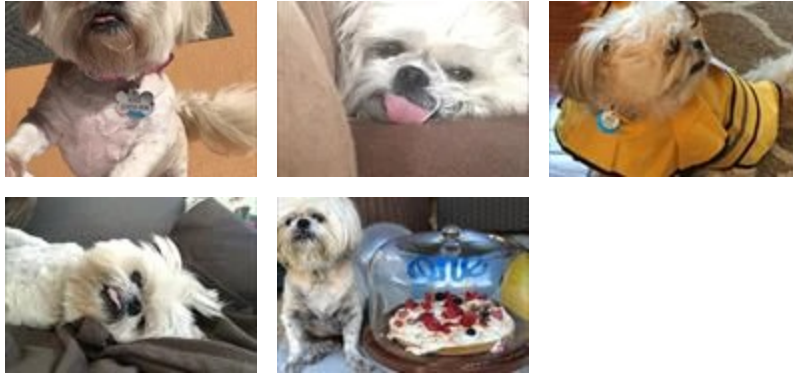
