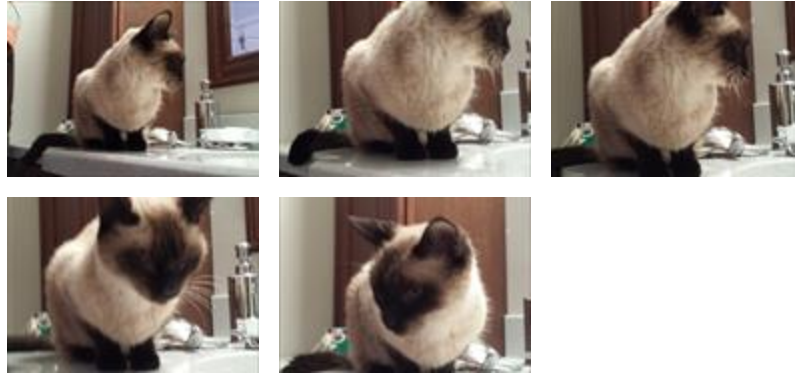

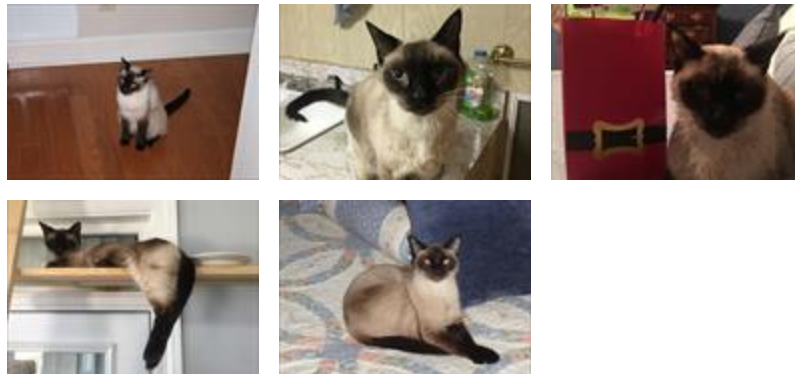

“ *Scrappy Barnes was a very sweet, loving, boy. I adopted him (and his sister SweetPea) in the Fall of 2008 at age 6-months from a local no-kill animal shelter. I was blown away by his beautiful blue eyes that he inherited from a Siamese parent. He and SweetPea were simply beautiful. They were both happy and healthy and a joyful addition to our family!!! At age 3, Scrappy started loosing weight. He had lost about 2 lbs in a year. After a few tests, it was determined that he must have been born with Cronic Renal Failure (CRF). I was devastated. The vet told me that he wouldn't live a normal life and it would probably be cut short. Scrappy and I looked at each other and were determined to fight as long and hard as we could. For the next 4 years, we fought the disease with KD and diet. He seemed to thrive. I thought we have this under control; but, the disease was about to show us who was in control. This past summer (2016), Scrappy started loosing weight again and acting as if he didn't feel good. I took him to the vet to see what was going on. Dr. Belser & the GREAT staff at Catisfaction became a part of our team to fight the disease. We had to admit Scrappy to the emergency hospital for a weekend until his kidney counts rebounded. He was a fighter! We were able to bring him home but we had to start administering daily Sub-Q's to help him fight harder. Once again, he began to improve and I was hopeful that we were going to be able to have him with us for many more months. In December of 2016 (right before Christmas), he took a turn for the worse. I knew in my heart that the disease was winning and it was eventually going to take its toll. I took him to my parents house for the Christmas holidays and he rebounded. He actually purred on Christmas day -and- he gave me hugs with his tail around my leg. I was so hopeful that we were making progress again. I couldn't wait until I could get him back home to his doctors show them how good he was doing; but, a blood clot formed and he was in a lot of pain. It broke our hearts to have to say "GoodBye" but we had no choice. Scrappy crossed the Caring Bridge on 12/30/2016 and is now one of God's special pets.
